Death of Stephen A. Borden.

Stephen A. Borden, well known among the residents of the southern portion of the city, died yesterday afternoon at his home, 132 Warren street, after an illness of about two weeks' duration. His death was due to an attack of Bright's disease. The deceased had been for several years boss painter at the Stafford road car barn of the street railway company, and was considered one of the most skilled workmen who have ever been in the employ of the company in that capacity. He was of a very kind and genial disposition, with a pleasant word and a smile for all, and had always been known as a man of sterling qualities and of upright character. He had a host of friends who will regret to hear of his death, and will sincerely sympathize with his family in the bereavement.
